LEE NAMED ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR OF STUDENT/FIELD MINISTRIES AT SOUTHEASTERN BAPTIST THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY

WAKE FOREST, N.C.—Ethel Burton Lee has been named the Associate Director of Student/Field Ministries at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary here. She began work at this position June 1.

She succeeds Suzanne Martin Davis, who recently resigned to move to Pittsburgh, where her physician husband is completing residency requirements.

Before coming to her present position, Mrs. Lee served as the Circulation Services Supervisor in the Southeastern Library. She received the B.S. degree from Westhampton College and has done work on the M.R.E. degree at Southeastern.

Her husband is David W. Lee, Director of Plant Services at Southeastern. They have three children.

Concerning Mrs. Lee's duties, Charles T. Dorman, Director of Student/Field Ministries at Southeastern, said, "She will have major responsibilities in the development of the Formation in Ministry program at Southeastern.
