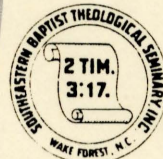
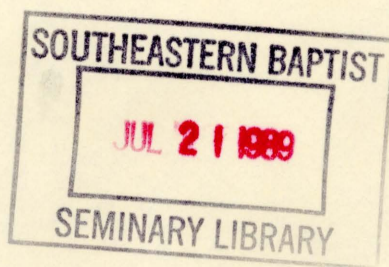

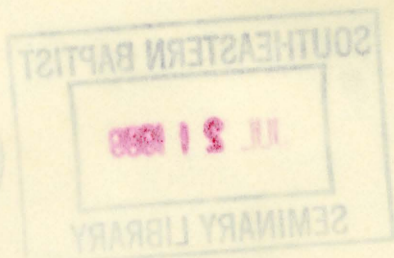
### SEMINARY TRAVEL TOUR:
