LEWIS ADDISON DRUMMOND

The Christian journey which has led Dr. Lewis Addison Drummond to Southeastern Seminary began when he felt his call to the ministry while a junior at Samford University. In the years that have passed, he has compiled a long record of service and devotion to Jesus Christ through teaching, preaching and evangelistic ministries.

Born and reared in Dixon, Illinois, he earned his A.B. degree at Samford in Birmingham, Alabama. He completed his B.D. and Th.M. degrees at Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas and his Ph.D. in philosophy at King's College, University of London, England. He also completed postdoctoral studies at Oxford University, England and Spurgeon's College.

President Drummond was ordained by Headland Avenue Baptist Church in Dothan, Alabama. He served as pastor in five churches in Alabama, Texas and Kentucky, including the Ninth and 0 Baptist Church in Louisville, the second largest church in Kentucky at that time.

His evangelistic activities include being a member of the Committee on Evangelism and Education of the Baptist World Alliance since its inception in 1975. He is also professor-at-large on the Theological Faculty at the University of Zagreb, Yugoslavia.

From 1968 to 1973, he taught at Spurgeon's Theological College in London, England in the Chair of Evangelism and Practical Theology. He held the first full professorship of evangelism in Europe.

Prior to coming to Southeastern, Doctor Drummond was administrative director of the Billy Graham Center and was Billy Graham Professor of Evangelism at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky.

President Drummond is a noted author. He has written twelve books and numerous articles on evangelism. These include *Evangelism: The Counter-Revolution* which was translated into Polish, Romanian, Spanish and Korean; *The Awakening That Must Come*; and *Charles G. Finney: The Birth of Modern Evangelism*. He also edited *What the Bible Says*, which was rated by *Christianity Today* as the best book on systematic theology for 1976.

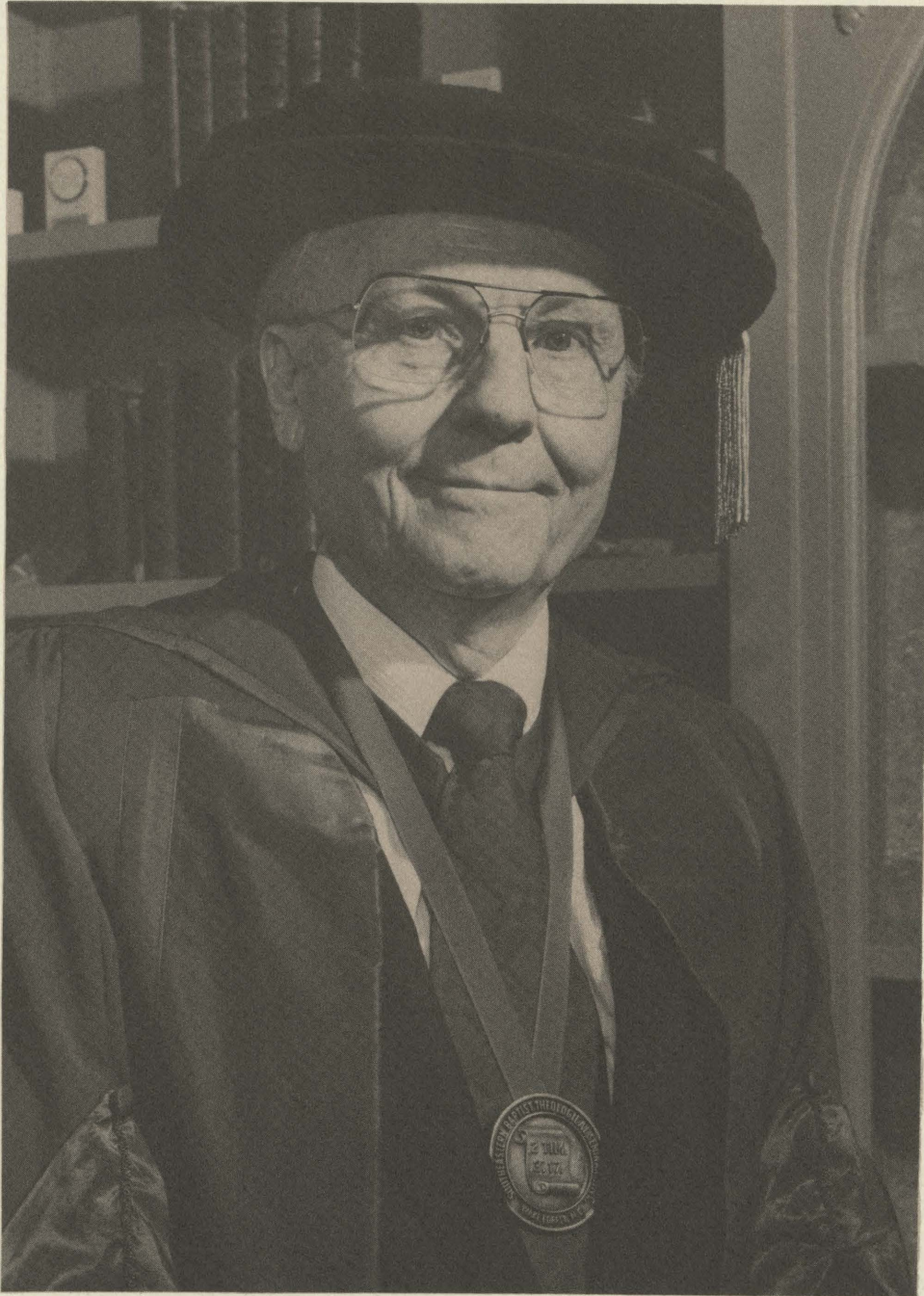
