BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS NOTICES:

(1) Heat to all campus buildings is provided by the steam boiler system, and

regulated by various controls in each building. These have been installed to conserve fuel through a timer control which automatically turns the heat off and on at designated times. Cut-off times are reset during extreme weather conditions or during times when longer study hours are needed. While it is impossible to meet individual needs with a centralized system, questions or suggestions you may have should be directed to the buildings and grounds office, extension 260.

(2) All members of the seminary family are asked to report any
