MINUTES

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 1942

The Association met pursuant to adjournment of last year.

The introductory sermon was delivered by Eld. E. O. Lilly, a correspondent from the Indian Creek Association.

After a short intermission the messengers assembled in the church house and were called to order by praise and prayer by Eld. G. D. Roten, a delegate from North Fork Church.

1st. On motion, received and read letters from all our churches except Beaver Creek.

2nd. On motion, organized the Association by electing Eld. Ed Davis, Moderator and G. E. Kilby, Clerk.

3rd. On motion, called for petitionary letters. Received none.

Miller, W. I. Brown and Fasco Pruitt; from the Indian Creek, Elder E. O. Lilly and H. W. Morgan.

5th. On motion, called for transient and visiting Brethren. The following came forward and were seated: From the Mountain, Bros. Tom Fender, Eddie Hoppers, Tom Rector and J. R. Douglas; from the Indian Creek, Bros. Elbert Morgan and W. E. Weaver.

6th. On motion, for the Moderator to make all temporary appointments during this session. He appointed to the stand today, Eld. S. P. Roberts. No special text.

7th. On motion, appointed a committee on the Ministry, composed of one member from each church represented: from Senter, Bro. John Reeves; North Fork, Bro. Jim Weaver; Horse Creek, Bro. Carl Ball; River View, Bro. J. F. Hartzog; Bear Creek, Bro. George Caudill; Cranberry, Eld. A. L. Pressnell; Big Helton, Bro. Cicero Spencer, with the delegates of Roans Creek church.

8th. On motion, appointed a committee on Finance, as follows: Bros. W. W. Miller, F. O. Thompson and Felix Bare.

9th. On motion, appointed a committee on Arrangements, as follows: Elds. G. D. Roten, W. W. Davis, A. L. Presnell, Bros. J. F. Hartzog, F. T. Miller, with the Moderator and Clerk, transient and visiting Brethren to sit with them.

10th. On motion, appointed a committee to appoint correspondents to Sister Associations as follows: Eld. G. D. Rotan, Bros. Callie Severt and Carl Ball.

11th. On motion, that the committee on Arrangements sit at Bro. F. T. Miller's.

12th. On motion, that we adjourn until 10 a. m. tomorrow morning.

SATURDAY MORNING, SEPTEMBER 12, 1942

The Association met pursuant to adjournment of yesterday and was opened with prayer by Eld. C. D. Hall, a correspondent from the Roaring River Association.

1st. On motion, called on the committee of Arrangements to report. Report received and the committee discharged.

9th. On motion, that the next session of the Senter Association be held with the church at Senter church, seven miles east of Jefferson, N. C., beginning on Friday before the second Sunday in September, 1943.

10th. On motion, that we bear with Beaver Creek for failing to represent in the Association.

11th. On motion, that the report of the Finance committee be received, which follows:
