PROCEEDINGS

The 159th Annual Session of the Kehukee Primitive Baptist Association was held with the church at Kehukee, Halifax County, N. C., October 4th, 5th and 6th, 1924.

The introductory sermon was preached by B. S. Cowin

It is agreed that this Association return thanks to God for the excellent weather and all other blessings, and to the brethren and friends of the entire community for their liberal hospitality in the entertainment of this Association.

It is agreed that our clerk have 2000 copies of these

minutes printed and sent to him for distribution among the churches of this Association and the Associations with which we correspond; that he record a copy on our records, and that he be paid \$25.00 for his services.

There being no other business before the Association, it was adjourned to the time and place appointed, with sing-

ing and benediction by the Moderator.
