

MINUTES

OF THE

EIGHTY-SECOND ANNUAL MEETING OF ELK RIVER ASSOCIATION

OF THE

Primitive Baptist Church of Jesus Christ.

HELD AT MOUNT MORIAH MEETING HOUSE, LINCOLN COUNTY, TENNESSEE, ON SATURDAY BEFORE THE SECOND SUNDAY IN SEPTEMBER, 1889, AND CONTINUING THE TWO FOLLOWING DAYS.

The introductory was delivered by Elder J. E. Frost—text, John 6:37: "All that the Father giveth me," etc. After which the messengers from the churches met and were called to order by the former moderator; singing; prayer by Elder J. J. Short. The letters from the different churches were called for and presented by their messengers; read, and messengers invited to seats. The letters show the state of the churches to be as exhibited in the table.

The Association organized by choosing Elder J. E. Frost Moderator, and John B. Bramblett Clerk, and R. J. Small Assistant Clerk. The Association then proceeded to business as follows:

- 1st. Read the rules of decorum.
- 2d. Called for petitionary letters. None presented.
- 3d. Called for corresponding letters from the associations with whom we are in correspondence, and with the following results, viz.:
- 1st. Flint River—Messengers Eld. J. W. Bragg, J. L. Kilpatrick; but no letter nor minutes for the reason that the yellow fever prevented them from holding their association last year. Brethren invited to seats.
- 2d. Cumberland—Messengers F. M. White, J. H. Hay, with letter and minutes. Brethren invited to seats.
- 3d. Mud Creek—Messenger Elder A. J. Wann, with letter and minutes. Brother invited to a seat with us.
- 4th. Sequachee--Messengers Elder Sam Bean, S. D. Collens, with letter and minutes. Brethren invited to seats.
- 5th. Round Lick—Messenger Elder L. P. Potter, with letter and minutes. Brother invited to a seat with us.
 - 6th. Stones River-Letter and minutes but no messenger.

7th. Collins River-Messenger Elder T. D. Nowlin, with letter and minuter. Brother invited to a seat with us.

On motion of Elder J. G. Woods, this association extends to all ministers and brethren who are not messengers, a hearty welcome and Christian greeting, and invite them to seats with us as guests.

On motion the Association adjourned to meet Monday morning at 9 o'clock. Prayer by Elder J. G. Woods.

SUNDAY MORNING. 10 O'CLOCK.

The Elders appointed to preach to-day did so in the following order: Elder L. P. Potter from Ephesians, 2d chapter and 19th verse-"Now therefore we are no more strangers and foreigners," &c.; Elder A. J. Wann from these words: "Open thou mine eyes that I may behold the wonders of thy law;" Elder J. H. Purifoy from Heb. 8th chapter and 11th verse-"And they shall not teach every man his neighbor," &c. We hope much good was done in the name of our Heavenly Father.

MONDAY MORNING. 9 O'CLOCK.

The Association met according to adjournment. Prayer by Elder J. W. Bragg then proceeded to business as follows:

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS.


Resolved, That the thanks of this Association is hereby extended to the breth ren, sisters and friends of this community who have so kindly entertained us during our meeting.
