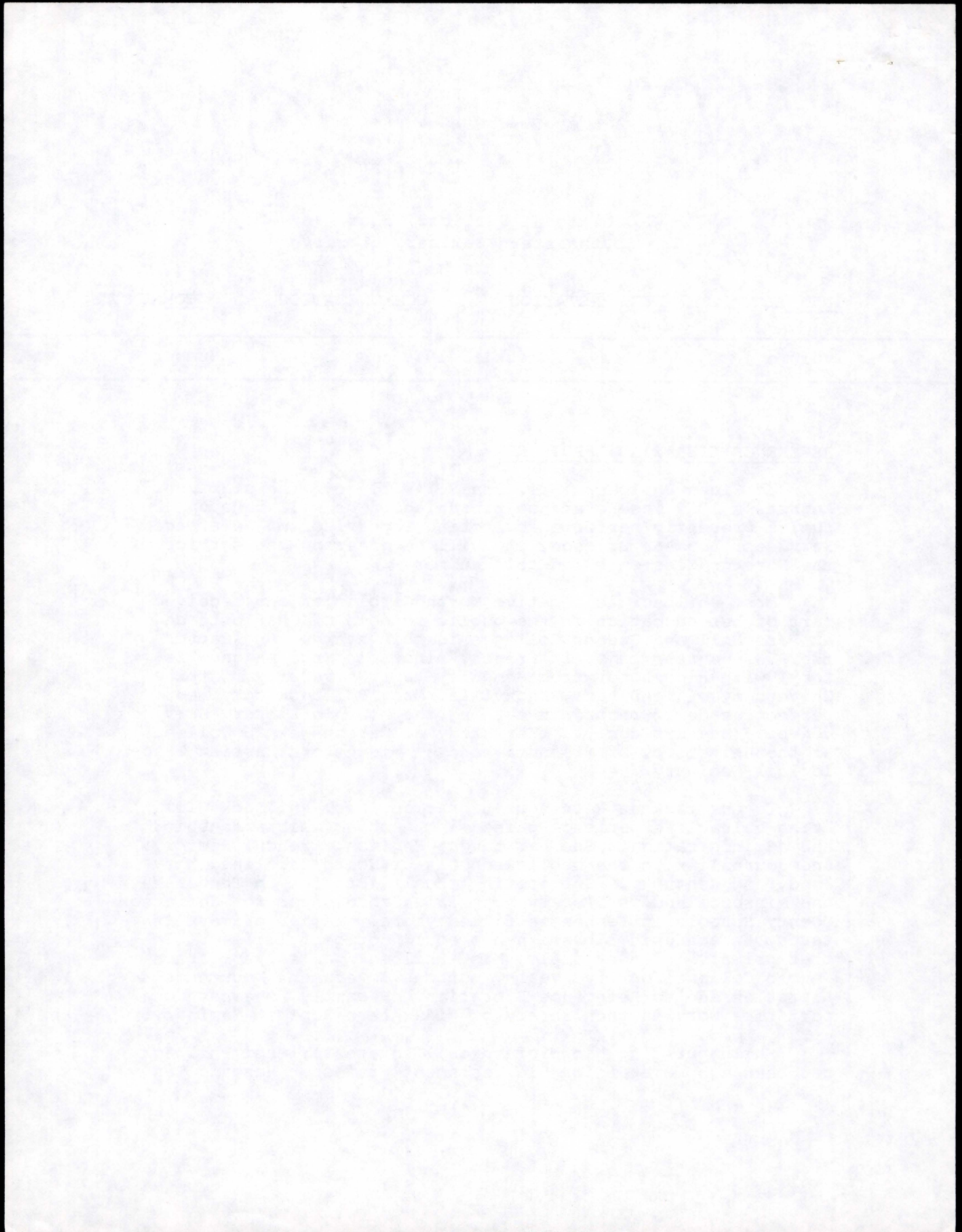
REFERENCE LIBRARIAN APPOINTED

Jo Sloan Philbeck (Mrs. Ben F.) will join the staff on August 1, 1979, as Reference Librarian. She will take up the duties presently performed by Acting Supervisor of Reference Services, Lou Ann Brisson, who will be entering the service of the Foreign Mission Board this summer.

Mrs. Philbeck is a native North Carolinian and received part of her education in the public schools of Charlotte and at Mars Hill and Queens Colleges in this state. She earned the B.S. degree (major in French, minors in English and History) with high honor from Memphis State University. At the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, Mrs. Philbeck compiled a perfect academic record in earning the M.S. in Library Service degree. She has done further study at Carson-Newman College, at the University of Missouri, and at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary.

To her task as Reference Librarian, Mrs. Philbeck will bring valuable experience gained in teaching, librarianship, and administration. She has taught English, French, History, and Journalism in the public schools of North Carolina, Maryland, and Kentucky. Service in school libraries in Tennessee and Missouri and as Library Materials Coordinator for Jefferson County Schools in Tennessee filled years when her primary interest in academic librarianship could not be fulfilled. In that primary interest field, Mrs. Philbeck has served Carson Newman College for five years, both as Government Documents Librarian and as Reference Librarian. Recently, she has done part-time work in the library of Midwestern Baptist Seminary.

While pursuing her professional interests, Mrs. Philbeck has been a homemaker for Old Testament Professor Husband Ben



and sons, Richard, 23, and John, 15. Meanwhile, she has somehow found time to be active in civic and church life.
