NEW EDITOR NOMINATED

In accordance with Section III of the ENQUIRY's Statement of Purpose, Standards, Policies, and Operational Procedures, Miss Carol Henderson has been nominated to serve as Editor of the ENQUIRY for the term 1969-1970. According to Section III, printed below, final approval of the Editor rests with the Student Coordinating Council.

III. The Election and Responsibilities Of The Editor

A. By the next to the last meeting of the Student Coordinating Council in the Spring Semester, the incumbent editor shall present the name of his/her successor for approval and appointment by the SCC. The nominee is to have been chosen by the editor from eligible members of the current staff; or from applicants submitting a resume of his/her experience and aims for the paper in response to an advertising of the position. The SCC shall by majority vote approve and thus appoint the new editor as nominated. If the nominee fails to win approval, the SCC may elect an editor from the other applicants, if any; or request an advertisement for applicants and vote approval and appointment at the following meeting. The new editor shall serve for a term of one year commencing with his/her appointment. The editor may succeed him/herself for subsequent terms with the majority vote of the SCC. The new Editor shall not be a member of, or candidate for, the new SCC.

NEW EDITOR NOMINATED

In accordance with Section III of the ENQUIRY's Statement of Purpose, Standards, Policies, and Operational Procedures, Miss Carol Henderson has been nominated to serve as Editor of the ENQUIRY for the term 1969-1970. According to Section III, printed below, final approval of the Editor rests with the Student Coordinating Council.

III. The Election and Responsibilities of the Editor

A. By the next to the last meeting of the Student Coordinating Council in the Spring Semester, the incumbent editor shall present the name of his/her successor for approval and appointment by the SCC. The nominee is to have been chosen by the editor from eligible members of the current staff; or from applicants submitting a resume of his/her experience and aims for the paper in response to an advertising of the position. The SCC shall by majority vote approve and thus appoint the new editor as nominated. If the nominee fails to win approval, the SCC may elect an editor from the other applicants, if any; or request an advertisement for applicants and vote approval and appointment at the following meeting. The new editor shall serve for a term of one year commencing with his/her appointment. The editor may succeed himself for subsequent terms with the majority vote of the SCC. The new Editor shall not be a member of, or candidate for, the new SCC.

- E. A two-thirds majority of the SCC shall be necessary to elect the editor.
