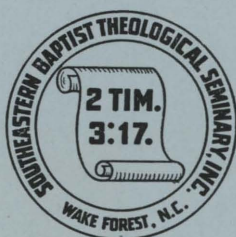

ACCREDITATION

Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary is fully accredited by the American Association of Theological Schools.

REGISTRATION

FIRST SESSION—Monday, June 1, 1959. Classes will meet four days each week, Tuesday through Friday, beginning Tuesday, June 2. Two courses may be taken. Four semester hours credit may be earned in four weeks. *Matriculation and schedule changing closes June 3, 4:30 p.m.*

SECOND SESSION—Monday, June 29, 1959. Classes will meet four days each week, Tuesday through Friday, beginning Tuesday, June 30. Two courses may be taken. Four semester hours credit may be earned in four weeks. *Matriculation and schedule changing closes July 1, 4:30 p.m.*

COSTS

Fees \$20.00 per session. Room \$12.50 per session. Meals, approximately \$2.20 per day. The cost of books and supplies will vary, depending upon the courses taken.

FACILITIES

A completely renovated campus. A new and modern cafeteria. A new air-conditioned library. Modern dormitory facilities recently equipped with new furniture. Rooms available for single men, single women, and couples.

RECREATION

Golf, Tennis, Swimming, Gymnasium. The town of Wake Forest operates a modern swimming pool. A private nine-hole golf course within walking distance of the campus will be available for a modest fee. The Seminary gymnasium will be open. Excellent tennis courts are also available.

CURRICULUM

FIRST SESSION, JUNE 1-JUNE 26:

The student may enroll in two courses and earn four semester hours credit toward a degree or certificate.

An intensive study of chapters 1-39 of the Book of Isaiah.

A survey of the origin and development of Protestant home missions in the United States and its territories, with special reference to continuing problems of evangelization.

CW 249s *Southern Baptist Growth* Mr. Wayland

A study of the factors involved in the growth of Southern Baptists with special reference to denominational program and local church methods.

LT 225s *Christianity and World Issues* Mr. Maston*

A study of contemporary world issues in the perspective of Christian social ethics.

2 semester hours 10:30-12:30, Tuesday through Friday

- LT 305s *The Atonement* Mr. Tull
 A biblical and historical study of the doctrine of the Atonement.
 2 semester hours 10:30-12:30, Tuesday through Friday
- CW 305s *Preaching to Human Needs* Mr. McKay
 Based primarily on the Sermon on the Mount with attention to modern
 techniques in meeting life situations.
 2 semester hours 10:30-12:30, Tuesday through Friday
