OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SECOND ANNUAL SESSION OF THE ORIGINAL MAYO PRIMITIVE BAPTIST ASSOCIATION HELD WITH MARTINSVILLE CHURCH, MARTINSVILLE, VIRGINIA.

MAY 16, 17, 18, 1980

# FRIDAY, MAY 16, 1980

- 1. The Association met with Martinsville Church, Friday, May 16, 1980 at 11:00 a.m. Services were opened with songs of praise and prayer by Elder Tolliver Utz. Introductory sermon was preached by Elder Robert Ashby—text: 2nd Chronicles, 6th verse and 2nd Samuel, followed by Elder John Ashby Psalms 144:1-2; 2nd Cor. 10:4.
- 2. Intermission for about an hour for lunch. Then the congregation assembled back in the Church. Moderator called the body to order and ask Elder W. S. Kelley to offer prayer for the opening of the business session.
- 3. Moderator called for letters from the respective churches and appointed Elder Thomas Radford to read the letters. Motion was made and seconded to enroll messengers and record in the Statistical Table as listed.
- 4. Motion was made and seconded to elect Elder L. J. Corn, Moderator; Elder Thomas Radford, Assistant Moderator; Bro. Weldon Wood, Clerk; and Bro. Fred Keatts, Assistant Clerk.
  - 5. Called for Petitionary letters. (None offered)
- 6. Called for correspondence from our sister assoications and seated same by unamious vote, Little River Primitive Baptist Association of Georgia responding. Brethren Elder Gary Utz, Aubrey Utz, Elder Tolliver Utz from Ebenezer Association of Northern Virginia; Elder William Fletcher, Ketocton Association, Licenate Bill Dillon from Amite Association, Mississippi; Elder Don Farris (Andrews) West Texas.
- 7. Moderator appointed Committee on Arrangements, the following Brethren Frank Keatts, Eugene H. Newman, Elder John Ashby to serve with the Assistant Moderator and Assistant Clerk.
- 8. Moderator appointed a Finance Committee: Brethren Noel Wilson, Fred Keatts, Landon Keatts, Weldon Wood, and Elder Robert Ashby.

- 9. Motion being made and seconded for clerk to have 500 Minutes printed and distributed or mailed, and to send copies to Salem, South Arkansas; Little River of Georgia; Ketocton; Ebenezer and Amite Association of Mississippi.
- 10. Committee on Arrangements appointed Elder Robert Ashby to write Corresponding Letter for next year (1981) and that we use the Correspondence Letter that we used in 1979 for this year. Elder Thomas Radford to preach the introductory sermon with Elder L. J. Corn, Alternate.

- 14. Motioned and seconded that this session of the Association adjourn until the next session of the Association to be held at Leatherwood Church in May, 1981.

#### ARTICLES OF FAITH

The following Articles of Faith were read and adopted without a dissenting voice:

1. We believe in only one true and living God, who rules all things after the counsel of His own will; and that He who created all things is infinite in power, wisdom, knowledge, goodness; eternal, immortal, invisible and un changeable; and this God has revealed Himself in His word, under the character of Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, and that these three are one; and there are three that bear witness in earth; The water, the Spirit and the blood, and these agree in one.

2. We believe that the Holy Scriptures of the Old and New Testament as contained in the King James Version are the written word of God and are a sufficient rule of faith and practice and that they are given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness; that the man of God may be perfect throughly furnished unto

all good works.

3. We believe that Adam fell from the good and moral state in which he was made, and that he involved himself and all his natural offsprings in a state of death, by transgression which is the original sin, and that it is utterly out of the power of man to recover himself from this fallen state by his own free will

and ability.

4. We believe in the everlasting love of God to His people, which was chosen in Christ, before the foundation of the world, whom He predestinated to the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to Himself and that Christ died and made a complete atonement for all which were given to Him by the Father, and that the choice or election was particular and eternal, unconditional on the part or will of man.

5. We believe that sinners are justified in the sight of God only and by the

imputed righteousness of Christ.

6. We believe that God's elect will be called, regenerated, and sanctified by the Holy Spirit.

7. We believe the saints shall be preserved in grace and never finally fall

away.

8. We believe that baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances of Jesus Christ, and that true believers are the only proper subjects of these ordinances, and that baptism is by immersion.

9. We believe in the ressurection of the dead, a general judgement, and that punishment of the wicked will be eternal, and the joys of the righteous

everlasting.

10. We believe that no minister has the right to administer the ordinances only such as are regularly called and have come under the imposition of the

hands of the presbytery.

11. We believe in predestination, as taught in the Scriptures and preached by the Apostle Paul and comdemn the doctrine of the absolute predestination of all things.
