## Litany of Mission

President: You who are gathered here today as graduates are not here

by a simple accident of circumstance.

Graduates: Whether by sudden insight or gradual understanding, we

have heard the same word that came to Isaiah, saying "Whom shall I send and who will go for us?" (Isaiah 6:8). And we each have answered, "Here am I, send me."

Congregation: You have come to this place in order that you might "be

equipped for every good work" (II Timothy 3:16).

President: But it is not enough simply to become equipped, for the

work lies before you. This, too, is the word of the Lord: "In Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their sins against them, and entrusting to us the

message of reconciliation."

Graduates: As ministers of the gospel of Jesus Christ, we are called to

serve in his name and by his example.

President: The same journey of faith that led you here now leads you

to other places around the world. You go to exercise the gifts that God has given to you and to employ the knowledge gained through study. But even this will not be

enough.

Congregation: Jesus said, "This is my commandment, that you love one
