





October the last Saturday in the month
being our regular Church Meeting day
And there being no visible separation of members
the regular clerk was present and
kept the minutes of the Meeting which
are supposed to be in his possession

Nov 26th 1887 Church Meeting held as usual
and supposed to be in union
the regular clerk also kept the minutes of
this meeting which we as yet have not had
access to

but our memory of the Meeting is
as follows - it was organized as usual
opened with singing and prayer I think by
Elder James Miller
after which the Moderator proceeded to enquire
of the minds of the members in relation to their
Christian travel and they expressed themselves
as being in union and fellowship and having
a desire to travel on together in hope of
life eternal after which Bro^r J. V. Bunchell
read a copy as he called it of a Resolution (the
Author was withheld) and urged its passage
by the Church but failed in the effort to get it
The purpose of the Resolution was that the Church
withdraw from the Lexington Association
and from such members as uphold four Ministers
of the Association namely Eld^r Herbert Miller &
Earle and refuse to sustain Eld^r J. V. Bunchell
over

after failing to get the church to withdraw
from the Lexington Association

Bro J. W. Winchell announced that they hold
a church meeting on the 3^d Saturday of
December next at half past one P.M. And
all that wished to go with them in person could
come A Bagast adds All that do not could
stay away

Dec 3

Accordingly on the said 3^d Saturday of
December 1889 about 17 members of the church
came together at the Meeting House - organized
and held then so called church meeting

R. W. Sanford B. Secor J. M. Binney &
J. Matthews were present but were not
recognized as members with them
after they were through with their business
J. Matthews was permitted to present
to them and read in their hearing
as follows

We do hereby express our heart
felt sorrow and deep regret for the course
pursued by you as brethren & sisters with us
in that you have departed from the order
of the Household of Faith and from the
rule and discipline of the Gospel and
from the union and fellowship of your
Brethren and sisters - at the expense of the
peace and welfare of the church
in that of assisting in worship
with ~~the~~ called churches made up

partly of members heretofore excluded from churches composing the Lexington Association and partly from churches dividing in disorder who have framed and so constituted themselves into so called churches and from thence into an Association calling it the Roxbury Association

Not in fellowship with the Lexington
 And that some of you have declared your intention to separate from us and unite with the said Roxbury Association

And again we mournfully regret your departure from the discipline of the gospel and your evident bad faith in the teaching of our Lord and Master - in proposing by a copy of a resolution (the real author being withheld) offered and its passage urged the purport thereof being to withdraw from the Lexington Association and from such as uphold four ministers of the Association

And from such as refuse to sustain Elder J D Hubble who has himself personally withdrawn from the aforesaid Lexington Association

Furthermore we regret that our Brethren and Sisters should manifest such bewitched and confused ideas in supposing that the Church can justly withdraw herself from her own Brethren and Sisters when they are not charged with any transgression

And we regret the apparent disposition to use your best skill in sacrificing your

Brethren and Sisters upon the altar of your devotion
 to one man for the purpose of enlarging his borders and
 promoting his person which you cannot do unless
 the Lord approve it &c
 and again we deeply regret to witness
 the apparent deception in expressing your minds
 one to the other as is usual in our church Meeting
 in a manner that leaves the general impression
 that you in union and fellowship with
 the Church and have a desire to travel on
 together when at the same time you have
 in your possession an article before prepared
 which if executed, to your knowledge would
 send the Church in two - and you come
 prepared to execute it
 and again we regret your departure from
 the rule of the Church and discipline of the
 Gospel in - that after failing to carry your
 resolution and your receiving no expression
 from the Church in its favor, you
 through Bro J. W. Birchall Moderator announce
 that you will hold your meeting on the
 3^d Saturday of Dec next at half past One P.M. and
 all that wish to go with you in peace can
 come &c Members of the Church opposed
 the more as it was to force them or the
 Church to withdraw from their association
 without opposition An Act which they claim
as peace - on this day there was no expression of the
 Church as a body no record read
 meeting broke up in great confusion


