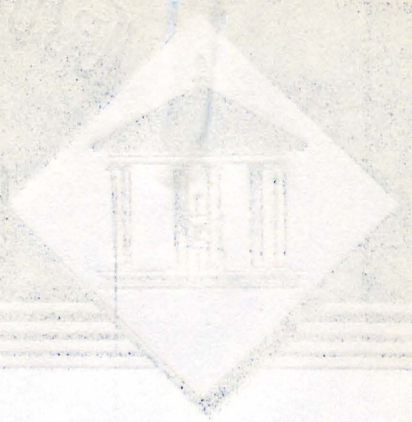
The Seminary Mixed Chorus will meet for practice each Tuesday at 7:00 p.m.
