- 30 The Junior Class will have a "Get Acquainted Banquet" in the Seminary Cafeteria at 6:00 p.m.

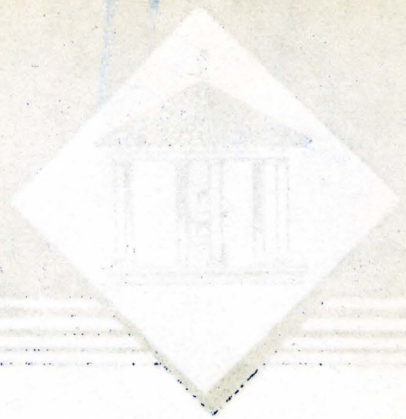
