

London

Served as an officer in the Royal Air Force during 1939-1945
war. Trained pilot.

Had ministries in three Baptist Churches:

Greenleaf Road, Walthamstow London 1946-1950

Fuller Church, Kettering Northamptonshire 1950-1958

Haven Green Church, Ealing, London 1958-1965

Lecturer in New Testament at Mount Hermon Missionary Training
College.

Chairman of the Council of Spurgeons' College, London, 1970-1976

Chairman of the Administrative Committee of Baptist Theological
Seminary, Zurich and member of Executive 1965-1976

President of Northamptonshire Baptist Association 1956

Chairman of the Baptist Commonwealth Society.

Hon. LL.D. degree - William Jewel College, 1963
Missouri USA

President of the European Baptist Federation 1962-1964

Became Associate Secretary of the Baptist World Alliance
and Secretary/Treasurer of the European Baptist Federation 1965

Travels widely in this connection and often in Communist
countries.

Appointed Director of new Division of Evangelism & Education
Baptist World Alliance in 1975 and will take up appointment
completely and move to Washington Office in October, 1976.
