

## Japan Curbing Foreign Schools

Under a new law Japan will strictly supervise schools conducted by foreigners. As soon as the proposed system of national schools is established the "evils" attending the operation of foreign

schools will be eliminated, it was announced by Education Minister Matsura in Tokyo. Prince Tomihide Iwakura, member of the upper house, an outspoken critic of the alien schools, declares that their operation leaves much to be desired from the point of view of promoting a correct idea of Japan's national policy. The purpose

of the supervision will be to inculcate in pupils the "patriotic" view of Japanese policy.
