In our search for a logo, we are inviting the entire Seminary family to join us. We will have a "logo search contest" during the month of October. The following guidelines will apply:

1. The design should be clean and simple in form.
2. The design should be instantly identifiable.
3. The design should readily communicate some kind of meaning, that is, it should tell the purpose of the Seminary or describe some aspect of the Seminary, such as the buildings or students or faculty or activities.
4. The design should be able to be used in a variety of places. It will need to be enlarged for posters as well as reduced to be used on envelopes, name tags, etc.

Contest Rules:

1. Entries should be sent to the Institutional Development office, Appleby 206, no later than October 31, 1976.
2. The contest is open to everyone - faculty, staff, students.
3. An individual may submit as many designs as he or she wishes; all designs should be clearly identified.
4. A public recognition will be given to the person submitting the winning design. It will be worth their effort.
