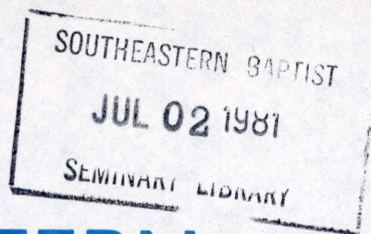

ALL GRADUATES
MAY 16, 1981:

M.Div graduates are eligible to remain in seminary housing 24 months after completing the M.Div program if they are enrolled in the Th.M. or D.Min. degree program.
