CHAPLAIN NAMED AT SOUTHEASTERN SEMINARY

Wake Forest, N. C. - "The well-being of our students and their families is of vital importance to us and we are happy to announce an expansion of our counseling program," said W. Randall Lolley, president, Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary.

Lolley made the remarks in announcing the appointment of Dr. Donna Myra Forrester, Raleigh, N. C., to the position of Chaplain. Forrester, presently a clinic coordinator in Raleigh, will assume her responsibilities in mid-August.

"The appointment of Dr. Forrester will strengthen our on-going ministry to the needs of our students and their families.
