SUMMER SCHOOL

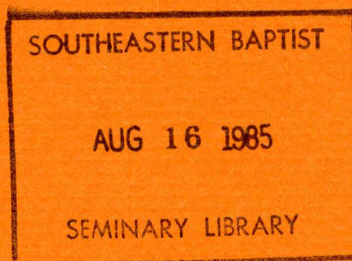
