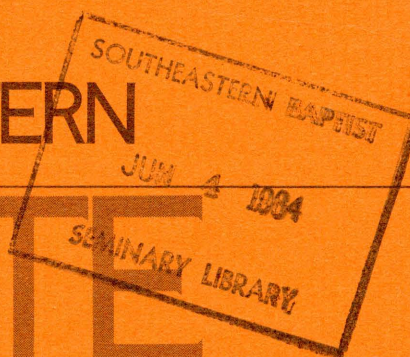

The spring music concert was presented on May 1. The Seminary
SPRING Choir sang "King David" by Arthur Honegger and
CONCERT Rene' Morax. The choir was accompanied by a
sixteen piece orchestra.

Mrs. Betty Weathers, Associate Director of Student Development,
BETTY WEATHERS was installed as president of the North Carolina
INSTALLATION Woman's Club, May 3. She will hold this sig-
nificant state post for two years and thus represent Southeastern
Seminary in new ways as she leads thousands of women in countless
service projects, some of them national and international in
scope.

The seminary family were saddened by the fact that late in the
evening after Betty's installation, her mother died of a massive
stroke in the hotel room where she had been with her daughter
for one of the most significant nights of her life. She was
buried April 6.

Graduation exercises were held on campus May 11-12. Graduates
GRADUATION numbered 185. These join the 142 persons who
graduated in December to make the academic year 1983-84 the
most fruitful in our history in the number of graduates.

Dr. Gene Puckett, editor of the Biblical Recorder, preached
the Baccalaureate sermon. Dr. Alan Neely, Professor of Missions,
delivered the charge to the graduates.

Southeastern alumni now number 5270.

Campus ministers from over twenty North Carolina colleges and
CAMPUS MINISTERS' universities were on campus for their annual
CONFERENCE continuing education workshop May 14-18.
Several Southeastern faculty and staff participated in this
important event sponsored by the North Carolina Baptist State
Convention.

Several significant academic activities have been conducted between
INTER-TERM the spring and summer sessions on campus. Among
ACTIVITIES these are:

- World Religions Practicum (Washington DC)
- Urban Studies Seminar (New York City)
- Central America Missions Practicum (Several Central American Nations)
- Practicum in Music Ministry (Several Southern Baptist Churches)
- Archaeological Expedition (Tel Dan in Israel). This program, under direction of Dr. Elmo Scoggin will continue throughout the summer.

The first term of summer school begins June 12. Enrollment looks
SUMMER strong. The teaching corps are excellent--consisting
SCHOOL of regular Southeastern faculty and visiting teachers.
