7th. On motion, adjourned to 9 o'clock to-morrow. Prayer by the Moderator.

3rd. Returned correspondence to the Flint River Corresponding Association to be held with Ebenezer Church, Macon County, eight miles south of Reynolds, commencing on Friday before the first Sunday in September, 1896. W. G. Middlebrooks, Elder J. W. Herin, T. J. Nelson, J. A. King, Wiley Green, J. H. Colquit, G. W. Davis, E. F. Trice, A. Johnson, Elder J. W. Bassett and J. R. Roberts.

4th. Appointed next session os this Body with Union Church, Crawford County, Ga., usual time.

5th Appointed union meeting with Pilgrim's Rest Church, Houston County, embracing the 5th Sabbath in March, 1896.

6th. Called for, read and adopted Corresponding Letter.

7th. Called for contributions from the churches, and received \$14.00 for minutes.

8th. Agreed to have 800 copies of these minutes printed, and Clerk to retain balance of funds on hand for services.

9th. Adjourned to time and place above mentioned. Prayer by Elder S. J. English.
