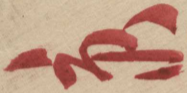

six, and so we did, and I was
appointed a Leader of one. I did

but after Praying about it, I decided with
Gods help- I would try and do the best that
I could. and in selecting a name for the
circle, we wanted to name it after a
missionary and we selected you and your
husbands. "Norman J. Williamson circle of
Calvary Baptist Temple" a few of us knew
you when you were here, we are proud of
the name, and the one for whom it was
named after, and we want you to know
that we are Praying for you and your
husband especially, in your work that God
will Bless and Strengthen you in all that
you under take. our circle meets on the first
Tues. in each month at 4 o'clock and we will
have a special Prayer for you both on that
day in each month. and we want you both
to ^{member} the Ladies of our circle in your Prayers.

I will tell you a little about our circle
the first year we didnt seem to accomplish
much, a number of times there was only two
of us present once or twice, I was the only

one of my circle³ present, but our
dearly beloved Mrs. Carswell met
with me, so we could have a
meeting, at that time all twelve
circles met at the church with a
devotional, and then each circle
went into a different room for
there buisness, and Mrs Carswell
usually met with the weaker
circle. and then all circles would
meet at the Church on the fourth
Tues, and have a missionary
program. and with one or two
others we Prayed and continued
faithful. and ^{the} Lord has Blessed
our feeble efforts, for now we

have a circle of twenty on roll
and at our last meeting we had
16 members and 4 visitors present
in our circle, we now meet in
the different homes for our circle
meeting and have a program at
each meeting, and all circles meet
at the church on the 4th Tues. and
have a missionary program.
our circle has adopted an orphan
girl in the day nursery and
home here, and we cloth her,
and we work one month in
each year at the juvenile

Detention home, we sew, mend, and give garments, and have a story our for the children and help any way we can.

Dear Mrs. Williamson if it is not asking to much of you, we would be glad for you to write and tell us of some of your work there I know it must it must be interesting we will be so glad to here from you.

Miss Francis Black is still with us as our city missionary down at the good will center and she is doing a great work here, she is truly a consecrated little woman. I will close for this time hoping to here from you at your most convenient time.
