SEMINARY COMPLETES TWO CAPITAL PROJECTS

WAKE FOREST, N. C. - Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary here has recently completed two capital projects designed to improve the housing situation for faculty and staff and to provide additional maintenance facilities.

"Heritage Woods," a 30-acre area within the town of Wake Forest, has been developed to create 26 home sites for faculty and administrative officers. The project is on seminary-owned land which is presently tax exempt. As each site is sold, it will become taxable by the county and the town.

The two streets in the sub-division have been named for the late Robert T. Daniel, Professor of Old Testament Interpretation from 1952 to 1959, and for the late Joseph R. Robinson, Burser from 1951 to 1955.

Also, a recently completed addition to the school's maintenance offices and heating plant will be used for storage and work areas. The \$47,000 building is a gift from Southeastern alumnus P. Eugene Williams of Midlothian, Va., whose company, Central Builders, Inc., of Rocky Mount, N. C., was the primary contractor for the two projects.
