VIRGINIA REPRESENTATIVE ON CAMPUS:

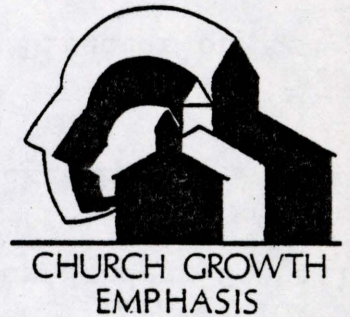
