#### The Carver-Barnes Lectures

Begun in 1961, the Carver-Barnes Lectures are named for two outstanding Southern Baptist educators: W. O. Carver (1868-1954) was Professor of Missions at Southern Seminary and W. W. Barnes (1883-1960) was Professor of Church History at Southwestern Seminary.

Richard Gene Puckett is Editor of the *Biblical Recorder*, the Journal of the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina.

He assumed his current position in 1982 after serving as Executive Director of Americans United from 1979-82 and as Editor of the *Maryland Baptist* from 1966-79.

A native Kentuckian, Puckett

is a graduate of Western Kentucky University and holds the Master of Divinity degree from Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.

He has served as pastor of churches in Kentucky, Ohio, and Florida. His denominational experience includes serving as a trustee of Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, of the Baptist Home of Maryland, and of the Baptist Joint Committee on Public Affairs. He has also been a member of the Committee on Resolutions, SBC; Committee on Boards-Agencies, SBC; Committee on Committees, SBC; and Committee on Order of Business, SBC. He served as President of the Southern Baptist Press Association during 1969-70.

Gene Puckett is married to Robbie Lynn Lake. They

have two children and a granddaughter.
