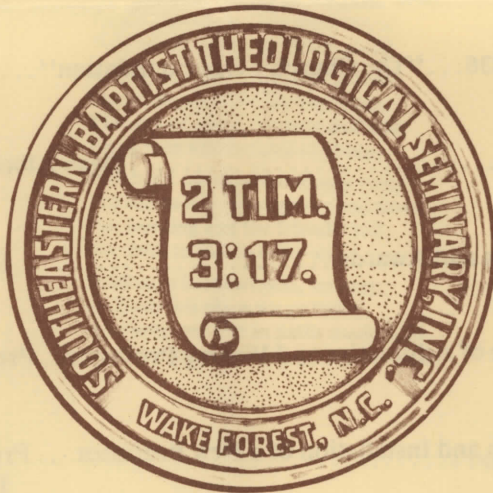

For faith to sow in every soil.

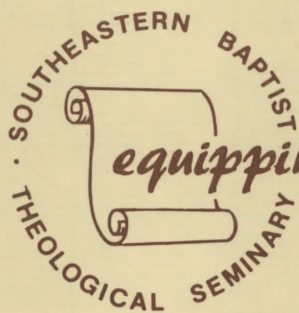
Bind us in brotherhood, we pray,
