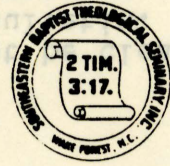
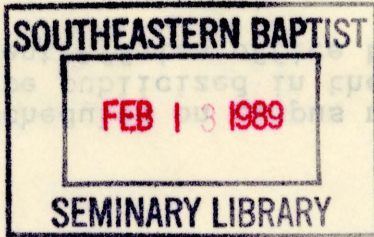

HOPELINE:

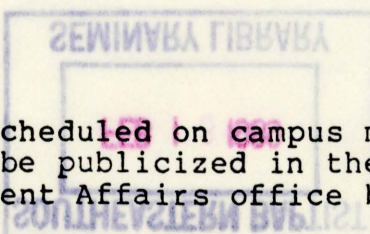
