The annual Southern Baptist Convention meeting was held in Kansas City June 12-14. The following actions related to Southeastern Seminary were taken:

- Over 25 motions were presented: most of them were referred to an agency or to the SBC Executive Committee.
- Over 30 resolutions were presented: one was passed on "Women in Ministry" which may have grave implications for the purpose of Southeastern Seminary: "to prepare God-called men and women for a variety of Christian ministries."

The first term of summer school ends July 6th. The second SUMMER SCHOOL term begins July 10th. Enrollment for the first term has been 421. This compares with 420 enrolled during the first term last year, and with 424 enrolled the year before.
