Primitive Bautist Association,

Held with the Church at BIG MEADOW, Chatham County. N. C., August 16th, 17th and 18th, 1879.

1st. The Introductory Sermon was preached by Elder A. N. Hall, from Acts 5: 38, 39

9rH. Elder P. G. Lester preached from Romans 7: 25. Elder P. D. Gold followed from John 10: 1-6. – Rain prevented the further services of the day.

10TH. The Association met according to adjournment, and after prayer by Elder D. House, proceeded to business.

11TH. The Committee of Arrangements and Finance reported; their report was received and they were discharged.
