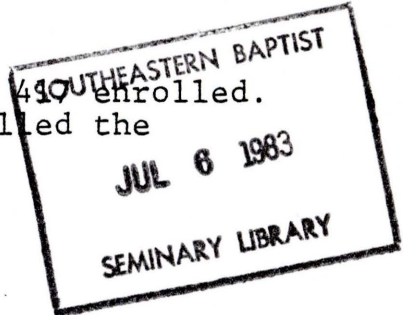


# update

The Southern Baptist Convention met in annual session at Pittsburgh June 14-16. Among the actions taken were these directly affecting Southeastern:

SBC

-Approved a 1983-84 budget for \$125,000,000 Southeastern receives:

Operating Funds -----\$3,707,795  
Challenge Budget -Phase I --- 750,000  
Challenge Budget -Phase II 1,302,415  
(Both Challenge Budgets are Pro-rated among 6 seminaries).

-Adopted the 1984-88 Capital Needs Budget, which includes \$2,703,333 for six Southeastern projects, including our pro-rated share of the new SBC Building.

-Approved a Maximum Contingency Reserve Fund for Southeastern amounting to 1/3 of our annual budget.

-Elected Jerry Holcomb, (VA) to the Board of Trustees as well as re-electing Mark Caldwell, Gene Curtis, Frank Jordan, Charles Page, and Harold Stinson. These trustees were elected for a five year term to expire in 1988.
