11th, Met according to adjournment. Prayer by Elder C B Hassel, and proceeded to business.

12th, The committee of arrangements called on to report, which was received, and committee discharged.

13th, Brethren appointed to sister Associations called on to report, who generally attended, and those who did not were excused.

14th, Brethren appointed to attend a Section Meeting at Wolf Island Church did not attend, and to Harmony all attended.

15th, Agreed, that we appoint Elders Robert Shreve, James Wilder, and brethren A. P. Robertson, John Somers and E K Withers, to Mayho Association; also, Elder G T Coggin and brethren Stephen Benson and John Wyatt, to Abbott's Creek Union; also, Elder James Wilder and brother W L Hampton, to Little River; also, Elders G T Coggin, A N Hall and brother Simpson Latta, to Contentney; also, Elder Willis Wells and brethren E J Hester and Sidney O'Bryant, to White Oak; also, Elder John Stadler, to Kehuke; also, Elder William Burns and brethren Richard Jones, Hiram Lockard, John Harris, Benjamin Willis and E K Withers, to Staunton River; also, Elders William Burns, and James Wilder, and brother William J. Gilliam, to Pig River.

16th, Agreed, that Elders John Stadler, William Burns and Willis Wells, be appointed to attend a Section Meeting at Flat River Meeting House, Person county, N. C., the Friday before the 4th Sunday in July next; also, Elders G T Coggin, J. Stadler and William Burns, to attend a Section Meeting at Pleasant Grove Meeting House, Caswell county, N. C., Friday before the 3rd Sunday in April next.
