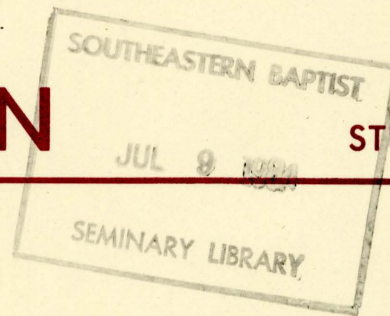
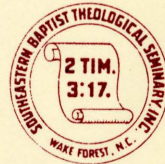

FELLOWSHIP HOUR:

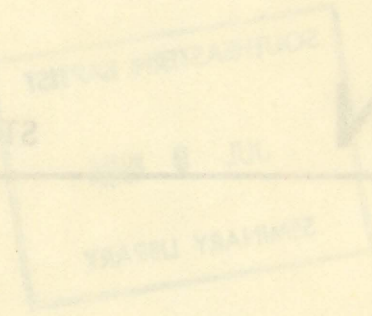
On Friday, July 20 at 10:00 AM, a fellowship hour will be held at the Seminary Cafeteria. Coffee and donuts will be served.
