Litany Of Mission

Leader: You who are gathered here today as graduates are not here by a simple accident of circumstance.

Graduates: Whether by sudden insight or gradual understanding, we have heard the same word that came to Isaiah saying, "Whom shall I send and who will go for Us?" (Isaiah 6:8). And we each have answered, "Here am I, send me."
