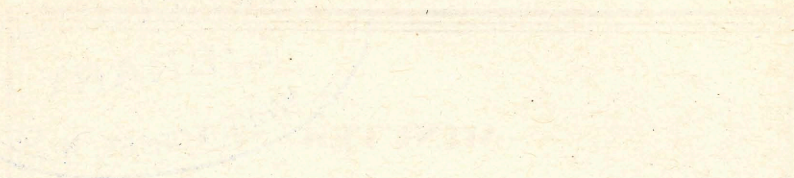

MINUTES

5. Agreed to hold the next session of this body with the Columbus Primitive Baptist church Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, after the third Sunday in September 1920.

6. Agreed to have 500 copies of these minutes printed for distribution among the churches.

MINUTES

ARTICLES OF FAITH

1. We believe in one true and living God, and that there are three persons in the Godhead, viz.: The Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

2. We believe in the fall of man and his inability to recover himself.

3. We believe Jesus Christ to be the son of God.—1 Tim. ii 5.

4. We believe in particular election; effectual calling of the elect, and final preservation of the saints.

5. We believe the Scripture of the old and new Testaments to be the word of God.

6. We believe that Baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances of Jesus Christ, and the washing of the saint's feet an example, and that no man has the right to administer the ordinance of Baptism and the Lord's Supper but such as are regularly called and come under the imposition of hands by the presbytery.

7. We believe that immersion is the scriptural mode of baptism.

8. We believe in a final judgement, in a future state of reward and punishment, and that of eternal duration.
