SPRING SCHOLARSHIPS: Applications for the spring semester financial aid scholarships will be available and accepted through January 27, 1989. Forms are available in the Student Affairs office, Ledford Center.

KEESEE RECIPIENTS: To receive a FULL Keesee Scholarship, you must comply with the following regulations set forth by the trustees of the Charles B. Keesee Educational Fund: (1) M.Div., MRE, and MACE students must take 10 hrs. (2) A.Div. students must take 12 hours. (3) Students must be taking classes on the W-F seminary campus to qualify for Keesee. Hours taken at Shelby do not qualify. * The Trustees of the Charles B. Keesee Fund have approved the Holy Land Tour course, B 1030 for Keesee funding provided the student participating in the course is enrolled for sufficient hours to meet the requirement for full-time students including the four hours credit given for this course. Students enrolled in CPE or Intern Year Away program do not qualify for any funds (4) Classes must be taken during the full fall or spring semester. Hours taken during Interterm classes and spring or fall break do not qualify as Keesee hours.
