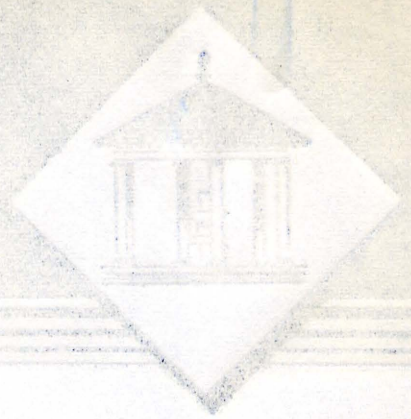
Chapel services are held each day, Tuesday through Friday, at 10:00 a.m.
