FEE INCREASE:

Students are reminded that matriculation fees will increase to \$300.00 per semester beginning with the fall, 1985 semester.

FROM THE BUSINESS OFFICE:

To register for classes, students must have a -0- balance and all fees (matriculation, student service fees, and surcharges) must be paid IN FULL IN ADVANCE. These fees are due upon registration. Those students receiving Keesee grants must, when registering, present their award letter from the Keesee foundation. No other scholarships qualify for clearance. All loans which have matured must be paid before students can be cleared for registration.

SPECIAL LIBRARY WORKSHOP:

Entering students and other interested persons are invited to participate in a special Library workshop to be held in the AV Auditorium, 2nd floor of the Library, Saturday, June 22, 10:00 AM - 12:00 noon.
