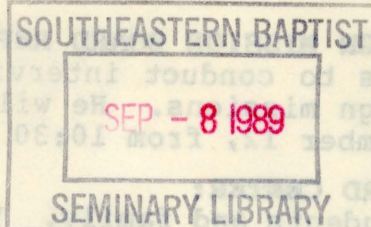

**LIBRARY COPY MACHINE:** The Library has two new Xerox copiers offering a number of options. Unfortunately, we had to raise the prices. Copies made with cash now cost 10 cents each. The machines will accept nickles, dimes, quarters, and \$1, \$2, & \$5 bills. The machines do not use the auditron/pass-key, but you can purchase a Vend-Card which will allow you to make copies for 7 cents each. Cards may be purchased at the AV office in the Library. Note that these machines have micro-circuitry similar to computers and must be turned off during electrical storms. When there is a storm, the Library personnel will secure the machines and lock the copier room door until the storm is past. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.
