

PROCEEDINGS — SPRING SESSION

Saturday, May 19, 1923

After singing, "Brethren, we have met again," Elder J. A. Fagg offered prayer.

9. Resolved that we return thanks to God for his manifold blessings, and extend to the brethren, sisters and friends of the church and community our high appreciation for all kindness extended to us during this session.

10. After reading the proceedings, which were approved, adjourned to time and place mentioned.


