Beginning with the first day of classes this fall, the following new policies will be in effect for library patrons: (1) M.Div., MRE, A.Div. and Guest Readers: initial check out time = 4 weeks, one renewal = 2 weeks; (2) Th.M., D.Min.: initial check out time = 1 semester, one renewal = 1 semester; (3) Due

dates are Tuesdays and Thursdays only. Tuesday due date for books checked out Friday, Saturday, Monday, and Tuesday - Thursday due date for books checked out Wednesday and Thursday. No books will be due on a day the Library is closed (e.g. Thanksgiving). Books may be due on a Wednesday at the end of a semester. (4) Fines are 10¢ per day Tuesday - Friday. No fines charged for Saturday - Monday. There will still be a one day late "grace"period. (5) Reserve books: All reserve materials which go out of the library overnight will be due at 9:00 AM the next day that the library is open, whether they are one day books or two hour books which had been checked out two hours prior to closing the previous evening. evening.
