CHURCH BASE DESIGN, 1979 UPDATE

Late in 1979, the Sunday School Board of the SBC sent us two copies of a major program design document for internal use by SBC agencies. <u>Church Base Design, 1979 Update</u>, is described as "a position paper about the local church" containing "statements of understandings and principles that will guide Southern Baptist Convention agencies in providing assistance to Southern Baptist churches." It was prepared by an interprogram team to update <u>Church Base Design, 1973-76</u>. One copy is in the Church Curriculum Center, the other in the circulating collection.

NOTES ON PERIODICALS

A recently-begun journal from England is Journal for the Study of the New Testament. It joins a slightly older Old Testament counterpart, JSOT, also published in the Department of Biblical Studies, Sheffield University.

Christianity Today's new quarterly publication, Leadership: a Practical Journal for Church Leaders, has an Editorial Advisory Board which includes well-known Baptists C. B. Hogue, Jess Moody, Bill Self, and Gardner Taylor. INTER-COM, Volume 5, No. 2

Consumer Action Update is a twice-a-month newsletter launched by the U. S. Office of Consumer Affairs on December 1, 1979. Aimed primarily at consumer organizations, state and local consumer offices, educators, and the media Update is designed to help us "track and participate in the development of significant legislation and regulations" that affect us. In addition, it includes brief descriptions of consumer publications, notices of certain conferences, and special news stories on current issues. Included with our free subscriptions, have been some recent parts of the Federal Register which present "draft consumer programs" of federal agencies for study and comment. Deadlines for comments on some have passed. An April 4 deadline is given for comments on draft consumer programs by the following agencies: Equal Employment Opportunity Commission; Federal Emergency Management Agency; Department of Health, Education and Welfare; National Credit Union Administration, Department of Defense and the Small Business Administration. If interested in reviewing any of those drafts, inquire at the Reference office.
