



#### ACCREDITATION

Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary is fully accredited by the American Association of Theological Schools.

#### REGISTRATION

**FIRST TERM**—Monday, June 14, 1971. Classes will meet four days each week, Tuesday through Friday, beginning Tuesday, June 15. Two courses may be taken. Four semester hours credit may be earned in four weeks. Matriculation and schedule changing close June 16, 4:00 p.m.

**SECOND TERM**—Monday, July 12, 1971. Classes will meet four days each week, Tuesday through Friday, beginning Tuesday, July 13. Two courses may be taken. Four semester hours credit may be earned in four weeks. Matriculation and schedule changing close July 14, 4:00 p.m.

#### COSTS

Fees \$20.00 per term. Rooms \$20.00 per term. Meals, approximately \$2.20 per day, may be secured in the cafeteria. The cost of books and supplies varies, depending upon the courses taken.

#### FACILITIES

Air-conditioned library and class rooms. Modern dormitory facilities are available for men and women. Married couples should write the Business Office concerning housing accommodations for the summer session.

#### RECREATION

Golf, Tennis, Swimming, Gymnasium. The town of Wake Forest operates a modern swimming pool. A nine-hole golf course within walking distance of the campus is available for a modest fee. The Seminary gymnasium will be open. Tennis courts are also available.

#### CURRICULUM

##### FIRST TERM, June 14-July 9, 1971

A course in elementary Hebrew, designed for beginners in the Hebrew Old Testament, will meet three hours each day throughout the two terms and will enable the student to earn six semester hours in Hebrew.

The student who does not take the course in Hebrew may enroll in two courses and earn four semester hours each term.

The student who elects to take M 366s the second term may earn five semester hours. Classes for this course will begin on July 12.

In order to maintain a reasonable student-teacher ratio the Seminary reserves the right to control the size of classes offered in the summer session.

**B 115s BIBLICAL HEBREW** Mr. Scoggin  
An introduction to the fundamentals of classical Hebrew with primary emphasis on the strong verb and basic vocabulary.

**H 209s BAPTIST CONFSSIONALISM** Mr. Lumpkin\*  
A study of the backgrounds, contents and significance of principal Baptist confessions of faith of the past and of the possible usefulness to Baptists of confessional symbols in the present era.

**T 309s CONTEMPORARY BRITISH THEOLOGY** Mr. Tull  
An examination of the principal types of British theological thought of the current century.

**M 207s THE OBJECTIVES OF PREACHING** Mr. Carlton  
A study of the basic objectives of preaching with a consideration of methods and materials appropriate to the implementation of these objectives.

**M 337s PRESENT ISSUES IN CHRISTIAN EDUCATION** Mr. Prudent†  
A review and appraisal of some contemporary issues in Christian education in the world today, including theological, behavioral, denominational and cultural factors.

**B 116s BIBLICAL HEBREW** Mr. Scoggin  
A continuation of B 115 with emphasis on the weak verb.  
3 semester hours 8:00-10:00, 11:00-12:00, Tuesday-Friday

**B 219s THE THEOLOGY OF OLD TESTAMENT RITUAL** Mr. Durham  
A consideration of the ritual literature of the Old Testament, with some concentration upon the book of Leviticus. Attention is given to the origin, development, and meaning of Old Testament sacrificial terminology, and to the theology underlying the cultic rituals of the Old Testament.
