DEVELOPING CAMPUS-WIDE AUDIOVISUAL SERVICES


Audiovisual services have been expanded significantly in the last two years. The use of AV materials and equipment in class-room instruction has markedly increased. Yet we have a long way to go in providing the services and facilities to enable the most effective contribution of audiovisuals to our teaching and learning and to our total campus life. Having "a long way to go," it is well to know exactly where we are going and to have a plan for getting there.

One of our library objectives for the current fiscal year is "to draft a comprehensive plan for campus-wide audiovisual services." Only a very preliminary kind of draft can be completed during the next four months, but it will be an important beginning and a framework for further study and planning.

We need your ideas, your perception of needs for the further development of AV services. Your contribution to the planning will be sought later in some structured way. Meanwhile, Ed Sansbury or Gene McLeod will be very glad to have a note from you with any immediate thoughts you want to share for our preliminary planning.





NOTES ON PERIODICALS

Department of State Bulletin, new to our collection, is the official record of U.S. foreign policy. Contents include major addresses and news conferences of the President and the Secretary of State; statements made before congressional committees by senior State Department officials; special features and articles



on international affairs; selected press releases issued by the White House, State Department and the U.S. Mission to the United Nations; and treaties and other agreements to which the U.S. is or may become a party.

Light, started about twenty-five years ago but long inactive, has resumed publication as the SBC Christian Life Commission's "latest word on ethical issues of interest and concern to Southern Baptists" (letter from Editor Bill Tillman, Jr., October 19, 1978). Issues dated October, 1978, November, 1978, and March, 1979, have now been published. We have none of the early issues; neither does the Historical Commission, but they have promised to try to find a complete file and microfilm them for us and others.

Emerging Trends is a new monthly publication of the Princeton Religion Research Center. The Center, founded in 1977, is a non-denominational organization utilizing the worldwide attitudinal and behavioral facilities of Gallup International.

Academe: Bulletin of the AAUP continues the AAUP Bulletin (including volume numbering) and absorbs the AAUP's newsletter, Academe. The first issue is March, 1979.

Journal of Marital and Family Therapy is the new title of Journal of Marriage and Family Counseling. The new title is said to more aptly describe the substantive focus of the journal.

Partnerscan, formerly Scan (one of two by that title), calls itself "a six-continent reading service for the renewal of church and mission." It is published bi-monthly by Partnership in Mission, Abingdon, Pennsylvania.
