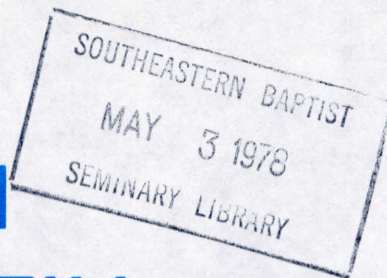

BRAHM'S REQUIEM: The Southeastern Seminary mixed choir will be joined by a 32 piece orchestra for the performance of Brahms's Requiem in Binkley Chapel on Tuesday at 8:00 p.m. Soloists will include Phyllis Mayo, soprano, and Curtis Campbell, baritone. The orchestra, organized by Professor Phyllis Garris of Meredith College, is made possible by a grant from the American Federation of Musicians. The Requiem will be sung in English and will be conducted by Professor Ben Johnson with organ and harp accompaniment by Mrs. Barbara Morrow. This performance of Brahms's Requiem will be dedicated to the late Raymond Bryan Brown, Distinguished Professor of New Testament Interpretation of Southeastern.
