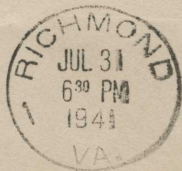

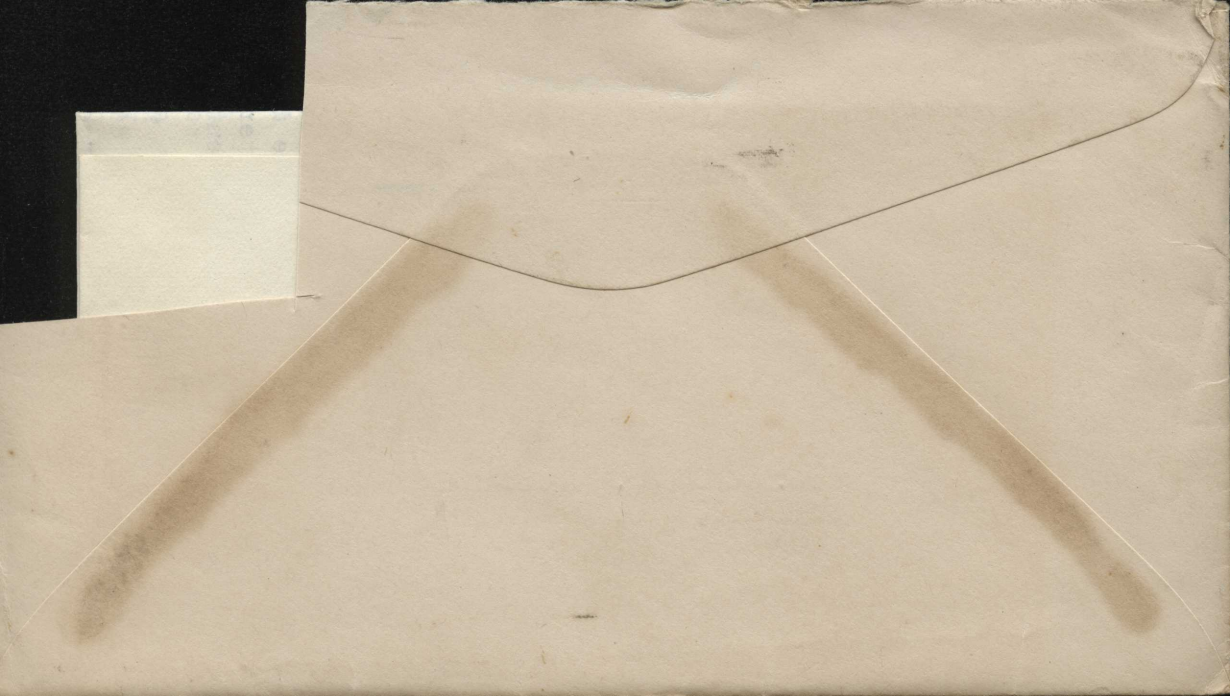

Dear Mrs. Williamson:

Your letter of July 26th to Dr. Maddry has come in his absence from the office until the latter part of August. I shall hold it for his attention when he returns.

With regard to the July check which you say did not reach you, I have looked up the correspondence regarding this matter and find that Dr. Maddry made an error in his letter of July 10th to you when he stated that the payments were to become effective July 1st. I quote below the action taken by the Foreign Mission Board on July 10th:

"That Rev. and Mrs. Norman F. Williamson, former missionaries to Japan, be paid an emergency grant of \$1,000.00 for one year, to be paid in twelve equal instalments, this grant to be effective as of August 1, 1941."

It may be that Dr. Maddry was thinking of the \$100.00 which had already been sent to you as being included in this grant. I am sorry that this mistake was made, but in this same mail you should receive the check due August 1, 1941.
