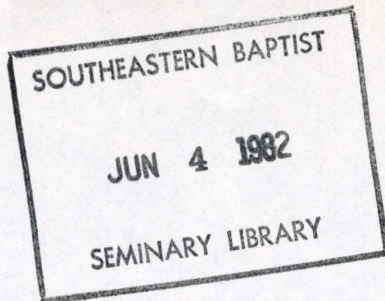

CHILD CARE APPLICATIONS: Applications for child care at the Ruby Reid Child Care Center are now available for summer school and for the fall semester. Summer school openings are available for children ages 2 through public school kindergarten. Fall openings are available for ages 2 years (by September) to public school kindergarten enrollment age. Children ages 18 months to 23 months will be admitted on a space available basis. A group for younger children 1 year - 18 months will also be available in the fall according to space and demand. PET POLICY REVISED: Effective August 1, 1982, the following policy will be enforced with reference to persons having pets in Duplex Apartments or Seminary owned houses. The determining factor will be the catalog for the fall semester when you entered Southeastern Seminary as a student:

(OVER)

1. If you entered under the 1980-81 catalog (orange), you will be permitted to have a pet (provided the pet is according to regulations in present pet policy) until August 1, 1983. After that date no pets will be permitted in any Seminary owned housing regardless of which catalog was in effect when the student entered the Seminary.
2. If you entered under the 1981-82 catalog (green), no pets are permitted after August 1, 1982. This is stated in that catalog on p.27.
3. If you entered (or will enter) under the 1982-83 catalog (red), no pets are permitted. This is stated in that catalog on p. 27.
