

SEPTEMBER 14th, 15th and 16th.

FRIDAY, 12 o'clock, Sept. 14th.

- 1st. The Introductory Sermon was delivered by Elder S. J. English of the Flint River Union.
- 2d. After one hour's intermission, the messengers assembled in the house, the Association was called to order, and prayer by Elder J. W. Bassett of this body.
- 3d. Called for and read letters from the Churches and enrolled the names of messengers.
- 4th. Re-elected Elder J. F. Sikes, Moderator, and M. F. Etheridge, Clerk.
- 5th. Appointed the following Committees: On Preaching—G. W. Davis, C. C. Elliot, from the Church, and J. A. King, T. J. Nelson and W. G. Hartly, from the body; on Business to Come Before the Body—L. A. Stubbs, Elder J. W. Herin and W. G. Middlebrooks; on Correspondence—D. J. Walker, L. A. Stubbs and J. M. Middlebrooks.
- 6th. Committee to arrange business reported that they had adopted the same of last year.
- 7th. On motion, adjourned to 9 o'clock to-morrow A. M. Prayer by Elder J. W. Herin of this body.

Met according to adjournment. Prayer by Elder S. J. English of the Flint River Union,

- 1st. Called the Roll.
- 2d. Called for correspondence and received from the Flint River Union J. F. Daniel, Elder S. J. English, Eli Nelson, E. Aultman, F. E. Glover, J. H. Jones and B. F. Simmons.
- 3d. Committee reported nothing on examination of Corresponding Minutes.
- 4th. Returned Correspondence to the Flint River Union to convene with Bluff Springs Church, Macon County, five miles north of Andersonville, commencing on Friday before the first Sunday in September, 1895. Elder J. W. Bassett, G. W. Thames, J. A. King, Wm. R. Thames, T. J. Nelson, G. W. Davis, W. G. Middlebrooks, D. J. Walker, Elder J. W. Herin, Elder J. F. Sikes and J. E. Rushing.
- 5th. Appointed next session of this body with Fellowship Church, Houston County, four miles south of Byron, Southwestern Railroad, usual time, commencing on Friday before the third Sunday in September, 1895.
- 6th. Appointed union meeting with Trinity Church, Upson County, embracing the fifth Sabbath in March, 1895.
 - 7th. Called for, read and received Corresponding Letter.
- 8th. Called for contributions and received \$15.50 for printing Minutes, distributed Corresponding Minutes.
- 9th. Agreed to have 800 copies of these Minutes printed, and Clerk to retain balance of funds on hand for services.
 - 10th. Adjourned to time and place above mentioned.
