4 Declaration of our faith in Christ

- 1st We believe in one only true and living God, there are three that bare record in Heaven, the Father, the word, and the Holy-ghost & these three are one.
- 2nd We believe the Scriptures of the Old & New Testaments to be the word of God and the only rule of Faith and practice.
- 3rd We believe in the doctrine of Election
- 4th We believe in the Doctrine of Original Sin.
- 5th We believe that Man is unable to Extricate himself from the dilemma he placed himself in by reason of Sin. &c
- 6th We believe that sinners are justified in the sight of God, only by the righteousness of Christ, imputed to them.
- 7th We believe that Gods Elect shall be called converted and regenerated and sanctified, and shall persevere in grace and never be lost.
- 8th We believe that Baptism & the Lords supper ordinances of Gods house & believers are the proper subjects of those ordinances.
- 9th We believe in the resurrection of the Dead and a general judgment.
- 10th We believe the punishment of the wicked will be everlasting & the joys of the righteous eternal.

The Church of Christ called Lees Creek
in order to avoid misunderstanding in the rules
pertaining to good order in the house of God,
agree to adopt the following rules, to be ob-
served in a Christian manner.

1st Church Meeting to be organized by the preacher
present as the Moderator, if no preacher then
the Deacon, if no Deacon, the Church appoints
one pro tem, meetings to be opened & closed by prayer

2nd The Clerk to be appointed by the Church for
a length of time.

3rd Only one member to speak at the same
time, who shall first address the Moderator
& when speaking, shall not be interrupted
save by the Moderator, in case of digression
from the subject.

4th No Member shall abruptly leave during
the Session without liberty.

5th The Moderator to have the same privilege of
speaking as another member, providing the
Chair be filled, but no vote unless a tie.

6th If any Member neglect to attend Church
Meeting more than 3 times, it shall be the
duty of the Church to appoint a committee
of one or more to hear their excuse and
report to the Church.

7th If any member, knowingly break any of
the above rules, shall be reprov'd by the
Moderator, if outrageous to be dealt with
by the Church.

8th Any member wishing to remove out of the bounds
of the Church, at their request to have a letter of
their present standing, to be dismissed from us
when joined to another of the same faith & order
